Fun and Games

We are busy planning our Fun and Games Day which takes place on 3rd July. On this day parents are invited to come along and watch their children while they take part in some fun activities demonstrating their physical skills. Nursery are having a morning and afternoon event. This will take place on Foundation playground. The morning session is 9:15-10:15 and the afternoon 12:30- 1:30. Children can stay for the remainder of their session or go home at the end of the event. Children who are in Nursery all day will take part in the morning and afternoon. All children will come into Nursery as normal at the beginning of the session to register.

Fun and Games for the other year groups (Reception, Years 1 and 2) will start at 1:30pm. Children from Nursery are welcome to watch with their parents. Our running events this year will take place during the afternoon as one of the activities.

On this day children are asked to come to school wearing their P.E. kit. We also ask that they bring a lunch in a disposable bag and they do not bring book bags so we do not need to return children's belongings to them at the end of the day.

We will send more information about these events nearer the time but we wanted to give you notice of the schedule so you can put it in your diary. We will be asking for volunteers to help us at this event. We are hoping that everyone will be able to come along and share the day and that Nursery children will all come back to school with their parents to take part.
