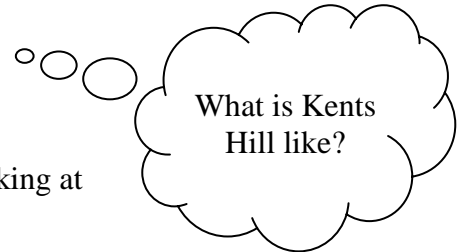
## Weekly Newsletter
